Morning Carpool Procedures

Children who are carpool riders should be ready to get out of the car quickly, efficiently, and independently. Please only allow children to exit on the right side of the car. Our “express” lane is the one on the right, closest to the school. The cars keep moving in this lane, only stopping for a quick “Kiss and Go” goodbye.

If you are parking and walking your child up to the building, please use the left lane and pull into the parking lot spaces. Cross only at the crosswalk please, the one monitored by a staff member. This is a good option if your child needs a little more help exiting the car or has heavy items to carry.

Early Dismissals

If you need to pick your children up from school before dismissal time, please send a note to the front office stating the time they will be picked up, the reason for leaving, and who is picking them up. In the case of a last minute emergency, please call the front office at 832-484-7100 so we can get your children ready for you. The person responsible for their pick up will need to come in to the front office with ID and sign the children out. We ask that early dismissal are communicated to us prior to 2:45, except in the case of emergencies. We also request that all early dismissals occur prior to 3:00, as after that our staff members are all engaged in the dismissal process.

Hassler Spirit Shirts

Clinic News

If your child needs medication during the school day, it must be brought in and picked up by the parent. Children cannot transport medication. All medications require written permission from a parent. Forms are available in the clinic. Prescription medications must be in original containers and will be locked and stored in the clinic. Any over-the-counter medications can be administered for a 2 week period with written parent permission. A doctor’s note is necessary for periods longer than 2 weeks.

If your child is sick and has to miss school, be sure to send a note to the registrar within 5 school days so the absence can be excused. A doctor’s note is best. You can also enter absences in Skyward in your family access portal.

Dismissal Safety

Please follow these procedures to ensure a smooth afternoon dismissal.

If your child will be going home a different way, please send a note or call the front office by 2:45. All changes MUST be made through the front office, rather than communicating directly with the teacher.

-For walkers and bike riders- Remember to walk your bike until you are off school grounds and have room to ride safely. Only cross the street with the assistance of the crossing guards. Head straight home without making any stops unless you have permission from your parents.

-For walkers that are picked up from the parking lot- Please only cross the parking lot at the designated crosswalk, near where the faculty lot meets the general parking lot. We will have a staff member directing traffic at that location.

For car riders- The only students who should be waiting on the front porch are those who we will load directly into their cars. If you are parking and walking over, your child should be considered a "walker". We will load students into the right side of the car. Please pull out of the way if your child needs assistance with his/her seatbelt, so we can keep the line moving efficiently. Use the provided hangtag to display your last name boldly from your mirror. Additional hangtags are available in the office.
